Long Beach Accountant Selected for Prestigious "Top 10" Accounting Award

To achieve this award, the accountants must first be nominated by industry peers or satisfied clients. The nominees are reviewed by the NAPAP research committee, which evaluates each nominee's credentials against the award criteria, and compiles a list of finalists from which the NAPAP Board of Governors selects the Top 10. Selection criteria include education, years of experience, areas of expertise, certifications, publications, awards, leadership, and client satisfaction.

Christian is a tax partner with Holthouse Carlin & Van Trigt, LLP. He is a nationally recognized expert and frequent author and speaker on State and Federal Location-based Incentive Credits (LBIC's), including State Enterprise Zone Credits, Federal Empowerment, Renewal Community, Indian Tribal Lands and Gulf Opportunity Zone Credits. He has also assisted in the development of specialized software, which is used by over 200 tax departments throughout the U.S. to identify LBIC's. He is also a regular tax columnist for the AICPA Corporate Tax Insider Newsletter and a contributor to the Long Beach Business Journal's "Dollars & Sense" column.

Christian has lectured at a number of universities, including University of Southern California (Masters and Business Tax Program) and California State University, Long Beach (Annual Tax Conference) as well as various business and tax forums throughout the country. He has also been a technical resource for a number of news organizations, including USA Today, Los Angeles Times, KTLA News, Orange County News Channel, KNX News Radio, KFI Radio and various business journals.

Prior to his current position, Christian was a tax partner with the international accounting firm of KPMG Peat Marwick and also served as Tax Director with a Fortune 500 corporation.

Christian is a member of the Tax Division of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants (AICPA), the California Society of Certified Public Accountants and Cal Chamber Tax Committee. Christian received a master's degree in Taxation from the University of Southern California and a bachelor's degree in Business Administration from California State University Long Beach.
